### DIRECTIONS

**From the Lehigh Valley (Rte. 22):** Take Rte. 145 N (MacArthur Road) approx. 9 miles to traffic light at far end of long bridge. Turn right onto Blue Mountain Drive and go approx. 6 miles. Entrance sign is just past the top of the mountain.

**From Philadelphia (Rte. 476 North):** Take Lehigh Valley Exit 56. Take Rte. 22 E approx. 5 miles to Rte. 145 N (MacArthur Road), then follow "From the Lehigh Valley (Rte. 22)" directions above.

**From New Jersey (Rte. 78 West):** Take Rte. 78 W to Rte. 33 N to Rte. 22 W toward Bethlehem/Allentown. Turn on Rte. 145 N, then follow "From the Lehigh Valley (Rte. 22)" directions above.

**From Rte. I-80 (NY and points northeast):** At Stroudsburg, take Exit 304 to Rte. 33/209 S exit at 209 S-Lehighton. Go 11 miles to Kresgeville. Make a left onto Kunkletown Road and then follow signs to Blue Mountain Ski Area.

**From Rte. 81 (Baltimore and Harrisburg):** Take Rte. 83 N to Harrisburg, then take Rte. 81 N to 78 E. Take Exit 51 onto Rte. 22 E to Rte. 145 N (MacArthur Road), then follow "From the Lehigh Valley (Rte. 22)" directions above.

**From Mahoning Valley (Rte. 476 South):** Take Exit 74 of Rte. 476, bearing left at the first "Y." Turn right at the stop sign onto Rte. 209 S. Go 1 mile to traffic light. Turn left onto Rte. 248 E. Follow signs for Blue Mountain Ski Area.

A variation on the fall cushions used by professional stunt men, the BigAirBag lets every skier and rider practice big jumps with a soft landing.
